The Top Drivers of the Year are the drivers who maintain a record of safe driving and embody the company spirit of professionalism and reliability. These individuals are evaluated for their positive attitudes, willingness to go above and beyond the call of duty and other positive qualities of an outstanding driver.

Each Top Driver is rewarded with 20,000 awards program points, a personalized MCA jacket, a \$100 dinner gift certificate and a plaque and certificate recognizing him or her as the top driver for the respective terminal. Nominees receive 15,000 award program points as well.

To be eligible for Top Driver of the Year, a driver must be a full-time regular driver who worked at least 1,560 hours during the calendar year of nomination. In addition, the driver must not have incurred a disqualifying event including disqualification from the Safe Driving Awards,

an unexcused hours of service violation, a driver chargeable 5500, written discipline or suspension or Department of Transportation disqualification.
